Effective as of July 27th, 2020, the Elk Grove- Cosumnes Cemetery District has temporarily appointed new Rules and Regulations regarding Funeral procedures during this trying to help reduce the spread of Covid-19. To ensure that funerals are uninterrupted we ask you to please follow the **mandatory guidelines** listed below.

- **How many can attend:** To maintain the healthy and safety of our guests and staff while maintaining the current guidelines mandated by Sacramento county, the number of attendee's changes. Please ask a representative of the Elk Grove-Cosumnes Cemetery District on current number of attendees allowed.
- **Duration:** Services shall be limited to 1 hour from the arrival at the Cemetery.
- **Must wear a face mask:** All Guest over the age of 6 years old must wear a mask. This includes all funeral attendees, funeral home personnel, Military honor providers, and cemetery staff.
- **Maintain a physical distance:** Must maintain a minimum of 6 feet of physical distance between each other during funeral services. **Mandatory** must be a minimum of 10 feet from cemetery staff and lowering devices while lowering caskets and/or ashes into interment.
- **Seating:** Chairs will not be provided for funeral guests unless accommodating physical disabilities.
- **Stay home if you are sick:** We ask if you have been exposed to Covid-19, feel sick, and/or have a fever that you do not attend funeral services.

The Elk Grove- Cosumnes Cemetery District staff has the right to halt all funeral services prior to, and/or during funeral services if the current **mandatory** funeral guidelines are not being followed. Families are not required to conduct a committal service and we understand that these guidelines may not work for all families therefor we encourage families to do direct interment when possible and then hold a memorial service at a later time when the Governor of California has lifted the restrictions on Sacramento County.
